### General

The participant agrees to accept these regulations and to obey any instructions from event officials and marshals.

### The event

The Ollon-Villars International Motor Race is a demonstration which is organised for your enjoyment and that of the general public. The aim is to relive the ambience of the events which took place between 1953 and 1971. The event in its new form is not a competition but an opportunity to see and hear the vehicles used in period along with any other interesting machines the organising committee feel appropriate. No timing is in place for the event. The nature of the hill and the difficulties it presents allows the participants to exercise their machines in a manner not usually accessible under normal circumstances. The organisers hope to create an event which is a spectacle attractive to participants and spectators alike.

### Laws

The event is subject to the Swiss LCR (Loi sur la Circulation Routière, in English, the Swiss Road Regulations) and the road will be closed to normal traffic during the runs. Special attention must be paid to the speed limits in Huémoz (40km/h), Chesières (50 km/h) and the section of road between the finish line and the Top Paddock in Villars.

### Ability to drive

**Please note that any person who is not physically or mentally capable of driving a vehicle due to the misuse of alcohol, drugs or medication which may cause or has caused an adverse effect on their ability on them to drive will not be allowed to participate.**

### Driving license requirements

Participants are required to hold a valid driving permit for the vehicle they will drive during the event. Vehicles must be presented for scrutineering and passed as fit for use before taking part in the event. Only the driver presenting the vehicle for scrutineering may drive the vehicle. Driver exchanges are **NOT** allowed.

### The participants' liability

Participants are taking part in the event at their own risk.

By participating, the participant waives any claims for criminal or civil claims against the organizer, its staff, helpers, volunteers or any other third parties.

Furthermore participants will be liable for any damage caused by the participant, or anyone in their party, who are responsible for any damage to property or injury to persons howsoever caused.

**It is the sole responsibility of the participant to ensure they have appropriate insurance, under Swiss laws, in effect to cover their participation in this event.**

### Participants' property

The organisers cannot accept any liability for the theft, loss or damage to participants' property.

### Event cancellation

The organiser cannot guarantee the event will run according to published timetable. The organisation reserves the right to cancel all or part of the rounds for weather, security or other reasons beyond his control. No compensation will be paid by the organizer.

### Compulsory items

- Helmet approved by the appropriate governing body,
- Racing suit (for motorcyclists leathers) approved by the appropriate governing body,
- Scrutineering ticket
- Driving license
- Vehicle silencer
- Homologation papers for the vehicle

### Number of entries

Due to safety considerations, the limited road closing times available and limitations of the infrastructure the number of entries is limited. Acceptance of entries will be at the sole discretion of the organising committee.

### NB Disputes and litigation

**In the event of disputes or litigation, only the general conditions worded in French are valid. The legal forum is in Aigle.**
